

Providing Financial Education

CorePlus is proud to support financial education in local high schools through our annual Financial Literacy Fairs. We hosted fairs at Killingly and Fitch High school in 2024, educating nearly 800 students from 14 schools on real world financial skills such as selecting a career, budgeting, credit, credit cards, and savings. In addition to the literacy fairs, we also facilitated budgeting exercises in the classrooms of six area high schools and community colleges. In the spring of 2024, we partnered with the Mashantucket Pequot Tribal Nation's recreation program to offer a four-session financial education program for their young adult attendees and employees.

In December, CorePlus launched the *Money 101: A Financial Toolkit for Young Adults* series in partnership with Otis Library. This six-session series provided individuals ages 16-22 with free opportunities to learn essential financial skills. CorePlus remains committed to empowering the next generation through financial education.
